The Anglican Diocese of Recife (DAR)

Total area of the Diocese:

1,554,000 km2 (600,002 sq mi; 18% of Brazilian territory);

Population of the Region: 54.6 million (27.9% of the country's population);

Anglican communities: 18 (9 parishes and 9 missions); Clergy: 24 ministers (2 bishops,

18 presbyters, 4 deacons).








The population of Northeast Brazil






The population of Northeast Brazil
